# Ten Essential Rules for Interpretation in the Asylum Procedure



#### Keep a professional attitude

Be attentive, empathic and respectful.



# **Ensure neutrality and impartiality**

Do not take sides. Do not express your opinions or feelings verbally, non-verbally or through your clothing.



# **Respect confidentiality**

Do not share any case-specific information that may lead to the identification of the applicant.



# Be prepared

Make sure that you are informed about the asylum procedure. Know the terminology and have all necessary tools and equipment.



#### Stick to your role as interpreter

Let the interviewer manage the interview.



## Be accurate and complete

Do not leave out, add or change anything that has been said. Take notes.



#### **Ensure clear communication**

Flag any obstacle to full understanding by all parties.



#### Be transparent

Inform participants when you need to ask for repetition, clarifications or breaks.



## Take care of your well-being

Ensure that you stay mentally and physically healthy.



#### **Ensure continuous learning**

Keep improving your language and other professional skills.
